• Empty the dust bag when 1/3 full. Do not leave the machine with dust still in the bag. Dispose of the contents of the bag in a suitable container. Always ensure adequate ventilation of the work area to avoid build up of combustable material. Do not smoke when operating the machine or emptying the dust bag. Punching down all nails will remove the risk of sparks from the sanding drum hitting the exposed nails.

Entanglement	Low	 Ensure that loose clothing, power cords, etc are kept well clear of the operating plant. Clear the work area of any obstacles before commencing operation.

Key Operating Instructions

Use only heavy duty 15amp extension leads. Keep away from the sanding path.

Clear the area of any obstacles, ensure all nails are punched down if applicable.

Use a power supply protected by a safety switch.

Do not use in contact with water.

To operate, check the sanding paper is correctly fitted and aligned, ensure the sander is sitting in the back position with the drum clear of the floor before turning on the switch.

To commence sanding lower the drum to the floor while moving off in a forward direction. As the end of each run is reached raise the drum off the floor.

Do not leave the sander in one spot or uneven wear of the floor will occur.

Keep a firm grip on the sander with both hands during operation.

Before attempting to change papers or carry out maintenance ensure the switch is off and the sander is disconnected from the mains power.
